

## EARLIEST DATES INVOLVING CLUBS NOW FORMING THE NIDDERDALE AMATEUR CRICKET LEAGUE

The dates given here have been obtained by searching various newspapers, mostly from the 19th century. These do not, and are not intended to, indicate when a club was formed as such, only that there is a reference to persons from a village or area taking part in some form of organised cricket, or that some sort of "cricket ground" had been established, to the extent that it was referred to as such in the press. It is not meant to be a definitive list and I would welcome evidence to the contrary. Unfortunately there are two clubs - Little Ribston & Galphay & Winksley - that I have not been able to find any information about.
